IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Lake Laws, Common Sense and Lake Courtesy:

We live on a small lake which makes following the lake laws more critical and not following them more dangerous to all of us.

*Respect Other Boaters and PWC (by keeping distance and motoring in the correct direction)

*Operate in a Counterclockwise direction

*Stay 100" away from docks and swim areas

*No Wake before 10:00 am AND after Dusk

*If you take your boat to other waters **PLEASE** pull your plugs, clean your hulls and all exposed surface areas with a bio-friendly soap, before entering our lake.

This will assist in slowing invasive weeds and zebra mussel populations that have already been introduced into our waters.*

(especially around beach)

- A property owner having the option to join the Association and not doing so shall not be permitted to use the beach
 as a guest.
- Members owning dogs shall keep the dogs off the park premises.
- Excessive profane and/or vulgar languages, violent and/or aggressive behavior towards members or guests utilizing the beach will not be tolerated.
- Adhere to signs and rules posted on fences and light pole.
- Please respect Park and Beach property including all grills, tables or other equipment that may be furnished.
- Loitering in parking lot after the beach has closed is prohibited.
- Jumping the fence to gain access to the beach property, is prohibited.
- All guests shall be accompanied by a member.
- Any member using the park or beach shall keep the premises clean and shall be responsible for the conduct and safety of their guests.
- No Fireworks on the Park Property
- The keys are patented. Legally the keys are not to be copied and are marked as such.
